God's Will for Jesus

MONDAY– John 4:32-34

Jesus had just spoken to a woman of questionable reputation at a well. The disciples question his judgement and Jesus responds to them about his purpose.

- The disciples are worried about physical food Jesus might of eaten (which he did not) and Jesus speaks to them instead of what kind of food?
- Jesus' desire was to fulfill the will of God who sent him, his spiritual food. How can you know God's will better? What is God's will for you today?

TUESDAY – Psalm 37:1-7

King David led a warrior's life for many years and reminds us of how he relied on the Lord in various ways through this psalm.

- What are some of the actions David prescribes? Do you do these in your life?
- As you trust, delight, commit and be still before the Lord, what is it the Lord will do for and in you? Commit/trust in the Lord every morning. Start today.

Jesus' Way is the Easy Way

WEDNESDAY – Matthew 11:27-30

Jesus reveals the important fact that he alone knows the Father. It is also true that Jesus is the only one who can reveal the Father to us here on earth.

- Jesus encourages people to do what so that Jesus can then do what? Jesus tells us to take *his* yoke and do what? How do we get so burdened today?
- Finding rest for your soul is what people need most in this busy world. How can you help yourself and others find rest today?

Attitude of Christ in Me

THURSDAY – Philippians 2:1-8

Paul tells his readers to be like minded in spirit and purpose putting others first. He said our attitudes should be the same as that of Jesus Christ, our example.
