& Musings from the Pastor &

When people talk about swear words, a common phrase used to describe them is a, "four letter word." Four letter words are often used in the heat of anger or stress, expressing extreme pain or discomfort, and at times for emphasis. Four letter words are crude at best and, I think the world would be better off without them. But even if they ceased to exist, something would take its place.

As I was thinking about "four letter words" and Easter (where's he going???), I wondered if there was a "four letter word" to Satan. A word Satan wouldn't want mentioned in his presence. Remember, Satan is the enemy of God and does not want people to be in a relationship with God the Father, Son, or Holy Spirit. Certainly love would work, but even for Satan love can be used in twisted ways. As I thought about what this four letter word might be, the word that came to my mind was HOPE.

HOPE defined by Merriam is "a feeling of expectation and desire for a certain thing to happen." When Jesus was crucified, dead, and then buried, Satan wanted all of Jesus' followers to have their hope squashed flat. Unfortunately, that is what happened. All of the hope that Jesus' followers had of him being the Messiah, God in the flesh, the one to set them free from Roman oppression, was gone! The air was let out of the balloon and there was no hope left for them in Jesus.

Fortunately, we know the rest of the story. Jesus DID rise from the dead. Jesus DID show his power over death. Jesus DID show there was a future life. Jesus DID restore the disciples hope! The hope Jesus gave now became a four letter word for Satan. Satan does not want humanity to have hope, you know, any kind of long term, everlasting hope. However, the truth is, Satan is winning over too many people's hearts, because they do not have the hope that Jesus followers do. No hope of an eternity. No hope of seeing their loved ones after death. No hope for a heavenly future with God where there is no more crying, no more tears, no more pain.

Yet, God has a plan to change this all around, a plan to give the disillusioned a future filled with hopefulness. *This plan begins with YOU!* Like me, we all have people in our lives that have very little hope, not only in this life, but in the life to come. Our goal before EASTER is to invite these family and friends of ours to find hope in Jesus. I'll do the heavy lifting by explaining where they can find true hope, *you just get them in the church door on Easter morning*. Yes, I know, Satan doesn't want anyone to have hope for their future, but God does.

Friends, in my spiritual form of math, God is greater than Satan, always has been, and always will be. So know as you approach your family and friends, the Holy Spirit goes before you, preparing them for you to ask them to celebrate Easter with you! God wants them plus you want them which equals hope for all!

Invite a Friend to Easter Service




