

& Musings from the Pastor &

It seemed like spring this year was cold to me... not enough heat! The weather people said our temperature was lower than average throughout this current season. Then all of a sudden, POP! The flowers are growing. The grass is growing like a weed. Yes, there are the weeds too, ugh! But all of a sudden there is life.

As I thought about how it seems like one moment the earth is dead, and the next it's teeming with life, I thought about life in general. As I was preparing to say, "Goodbye" to one who was dying, I was at the same time saying, "Hello" to another who had just entered the world. Even when we cannot see it, life is still moving forward. To the one who did die, they may no longer be a part of this physical world in which we live, but they are moving on to a life that is far glorious than the one they'd already experienced. To the one just born, there is so much ahead of them it is overwhelming.

When I see people, I see them in terms of where they are in their lives. My kids have so much more life to live, while I on the other still have many years left, but less time to live them. As this summer plays out in your life, take some time to renew your faith. Come on Sundays to really worship God, to encounter God, to hear from God. Simply come, and God will meet you here.



Outside Summer Service


