## »Musings from the Pastor «


I saw a report from a local Gideon's group I've had the pleasure to meet with a few times over the last few years. It was encouraging to see the work they are doing in getting God's Word (New Testaments) into people's hands. The numbers were these:

Fowlerville Family Fair – gave out 892 New Testaments to many young peop	le and
witnessed to some as we engaged them in conversa	ations.
Howell Melon Fest —— handed out 1120 New Testaments and shared with about Jesus Christ.	some

These are encouraging numbers. To see God's Word getting shared at these fairs and festivals is so important. Who knows how many of the nearly 2000 people who received a New Testament will open and read life changing words like:

#### Yet to all who did receive him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God. (John 1:12)

I remember receiving one fall day as I was headed to class at Central Michigan University a Gideon New Testament. Although I had unintentionally been distancing myself from God through my college years, this little New Testament was a reminder of God's presence in the world and in my life. God would use this little New Testament, along with other "God moments" during these wayward years to draw me back into a stronger relationship with Jesus.



I sometimes believe we minimize what we can do to help others in their relationship with God. Yet, acts of kindness,

uplifting words of blessing, playing Christian music that other's might hear, saying you'll pray for someone who is going through a difficult spot in life are simple, but effective ways we can reach out with God's love. When we minimize our efforts, Satan, not God, gets the glory, which is never a good thing. When prompted by the Spirit, reach out to others!

I cannot say I read much of that little orange covered New Testament a guy from Gideon's handed me on that fall day. But I do remember the moment. I do remember knowing God was present on those pages of the New Testament. I was convicted in knowing I wasn't actively seeking God. I felt a little Holy Spirit induced guilt because I wasn't involved in a church or any real spiritual practice. But in that moment, and the moments I have thought back to that day, I thank God for someone's act of love to me.
