Devotions

And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him. – Heb 11:6

This week, begin your quiet time with God by having your Bible and some paper/notebook in which to write. Use the following instructions for your time with God:

- 1. Ask God to first quiet your heart and mind so that you are available to God.
- 2. Ask God to speak to your heart as you read Luke 7:11-17 each day this week.
 - a. Realize in this scripture there are various people who experience what happened from their angle. These people have experienced Jesus, and Jesus meets them at their particular need.
 - b. After reading this scripture, each day write down a time when God has helped you to make a spiritual transition, decision, or take a spiritually new direction in your life. These are called Spiritual Markers. You may use suggestions below to help prompt you each day this week.

Spiritual Marker Prompts

- ➤ MONDAY- When did God become real to you?
- > TUESDAY When the church became the body of Christ to you.
- > WEDNESDAY When you felt the Bible was really more than just stories, but God speaking to you.
- > THURSDAY When someone helped direct you closer to God or helped you to see God more personally.
- > FRIDAY A special study you undertook with others which helped you deepen your spiritual life.
