Sermon Notes February 24, 2019 THE CHURCH: Seeking to Sanctify

Jesus speaks of two spiritual competitors for our belief in Jesus:

- The <u>world</u> around us.
- The <u>Evil</u> one, known also as <u>Satan</u>.

Statistics bear out the following:

- Worldwide, only about <u>32</u>% claim to be <u>Christian</u>.
- In the U.S.
 - \circ about <u>75</u>% of all people say they <u>believe</u> in God.
 - Only <u>62</u>% of those who believe in God would say that <u>Jesus</u> is God.
 - For the 75% who believe in a God:
 - About <u>46.5</u> % believe Jesus <u>is</u> God.
 - About 28.5% only believe in <u>a</u> God.
 - So when someone says they believe in God, more than half (<u>53.5</u>%) do not believe in Jesus <u>as</u> God.
 - More than <u>half</u> of all people will spend their eternity <u>separated</u> from God.

If Jesus <u>prays</u> for protection from the world/Satan for <u>us</u>, we should <u>pray</u> for it too.

When Jesus asks God to <u>sanctify</u>, Jesus is asking the Father to <u>purify</u> the disciple's soul.

- Jesus sanctifies himself that <u>others</u> may be <u>sanctified</u> too.
- We need to be purified that <u>others</u> may become <u>purified</u> too.

Weekly Devotions
