United Methodist Church

According to a Gallup Poll (pre-covid) the 4 most common New Year's Resolutions are (1) Personal Financial Gain, (2) Quit Smoking, (3) Lose Weight, (4) More Exercise...John Wesley developed from a chapter of a Puritan publication an extended order of worship to be used in the Methodist movement. It was and is often used as an extended New Year's watchnight service. What follows is a shortened and slightly modernized taste of the covenant service: It is presented as a responsive reading between a leader and people. The "resolutions" are numbered (x).

- L: Give yourselves to Christ that you may belong to him as his committed servants. He has many services to be done. Some are easy, some difficult. Some are honored, some are not. Some fit with our natural interests, some do not. In some, we may please Christ and please ourselves. But in other works of service, we can please Christ only by denying ourselves. Deliberate, then; what it means to follow Christ -- in a guided responsive prayer.
- P: Let me be your servant. I give up myself to your will in all things.
- L: Trust that Christ shall give you just the right place and work.
- P: Lord, make me what you will. I put myself fully into your hands: put me to doing, to suffering, to fulfill a task for you, or to step aside so you can call others to that mission. Let me be full, or empty. Let me have all, or nothing. I freely and willingly give all to your pleasure and disposal.
- L: Christ will force no one to serve without their consent, but will not accept anything less that *full* consent to *all* that he requires. Christ will be all, or he will be nothing. Carefully consider the conditions needed to make this covenant a reality in your life. (1) Spend regular time alone with God, giving your life to Christ, confessing your sins, and choosing to follow *only* and *all* his holy laws.
- P: We will be clear in these things, that we will not lie to God or ourselves.
- L: (2) Practice your faith in a spirit of holy awe and reverence. (3) Claim God's covenant -- rely on his grace and strength so you can keep your promise.
- P: We will not trust our own strength and power.
- L: (4) Resolve to be faithful. You've given your hearts, confessed with your words, and dedicated your lives to God.
- P: By God's power, we will never go back.
- L: (5) Finally, then; renew your covenant with the Lord.
- P: I bow my heart before you. Forgive my failures to fulfill your will. You promise mercy if I turn to you with my whole heart.

IF YOU DON'T HAVE ZOOM:

If you have an meeting invitation link, click on the link. It will give you instructions for downloading.



If you don't have an invitation link, or the link doesn't work. **On your computer** Go to Zoom.com Click on "Join a Meeting". It will give you instructions to download/install zoom.

On your smart phone

Go to: app store, google play, etc.. Search for "Zoom" Install it.

WHEN YOU HAVE ZOOM

If you have an meeting invitation link, click on the link.

If you don not have a link, open zoom. Click/Touch "Join a Meeting"

Type in **Meeting ID: 969 9365 4405** (include spaces if your application doesn't do it automatically)

Password (8 "1"s): 11111111

You will be asked if you want to join by video and by audio. Click yes if you want to be seen and be heard. There is an option of testing the mic and speakers.

During/After a meeting

You can mute/unmute your microphone or camera by touching the microphone/camera icons on the task bar at the bottom of the zoom window. Hovering the mouse or tapping your phone may be necessary for the task bar to appear. In some applications this toggling option is found by hovering/tapping the upper right corner of your personal participant square.

When the meeting is over, find and click/touch the **Leave Meeting** button on the task bar. Click the confirmation button to leave.

- P: You are my Lord and God. I renounce my will and take your will as my law. I will give my body, soul, mind and strength and promise to serve you in holiness all of my days.
- L: God has given holy laws as the rule of your life. All his laws are holy, just and good.
- P: I take them as the rule of my thoughts, words, and actions, organizing my life according to your direction.
- L: The Almighty God searches and knows your heart and desires to be your covenant friend. Therefore, may the covenant you have made on earth be ratified in heaven.
