



Financial News

The Finance Committee wishes to thank all who provided financial support to the Church over the past few months. Thanks to everyone's faithful giving, the Church continues to meet all financial obligations except for our Ministry Shares paid to the United Methodist Conference of Michigan. As we move towards the end of the year, we would like to consider having a Ministry Shares Catch Up Offering. This will be discussed and decided at the November Administrative Council meeting. As of today, we owe \$14,000 for 2021 Ministry Shares.

I'm sure you all have noticed how nice the parking lot appears after seal coating and restriping. The Trustees did a great job of negotiating the fee for this work and asked for \$5,000 to be allocated. At the time we felt it may take all winter to build up a reserve for this project. Thank the Lord, a few days later a donation from the estate of a former member arrive for \$5,000.

I was recently asked how the Church was doing paying off the addition to the Church. We call this the Armstrong Hall Loan and people have been giving to the Building Fund to support monthly payments. In January 2020, the loan was moved to a very low interest rate allowing the monthly payment to go from \$1,005 a month to \$666.35 per month and will be paid off in 2024. As of today, we owe \$26,000.

Here is an overview of what is spent and how much money is received to pay bills and payroll for each month. When or if it becomes critical, we will issue a special plea as was done in April. For any of you who would like additional information, please contact me directly.
