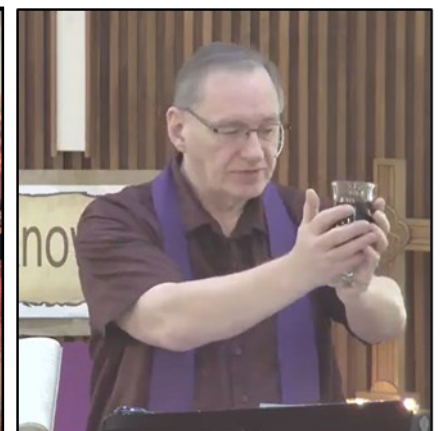
Recent Worship in Pictures



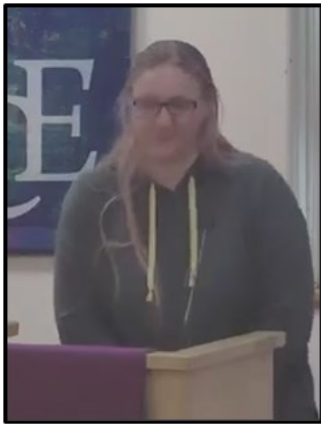
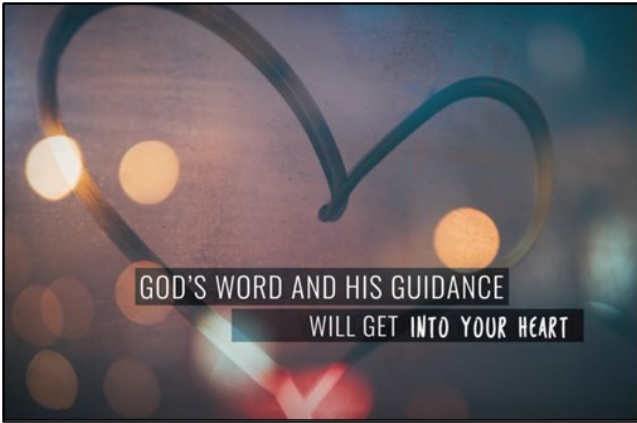
March 2 (Ash Wed) - Above left to right: Donna Allmond accompanies nearly all our services (except praise band Sundays), on this night she was at the keyboard while the regular piano was out for repairs. Pastor Chuck leads the formal service and breaks the Communion bread. **Right** -- The "ashen cross" symbol was self-applied to our hands.



March 6 - Lower Left - The Worship team put together an altar display emphasizing the Jesus lighting the way to the cross, (right side of altar) tiered candles on the left and a scroll above the centrally positioned Bible with a weekly key word that would highlight a foundational principle in building a rock-solid relationship with Jesus. **Lower Right** - Pastor Chuck places a foundational stone (a new brick is added each week) on the table (off camera) **Bottom Left to Right** - Jerry Weaver leads the lay and congregational readings. This series contains a short video that emphasizes the point of the day. Pastor lifts the cup of communion near the end of the service.

Mar 13th - Above, left to right The theme was **listening** to Jesus' guidance, Pastor Chuck leads the prayers surrounded by the Lenten altar scape behind, and the Lenten Meditation table in front. **Left**, Sara led the readings of the day. The praise band (no picture) led the music of the day...

March 20th - Lower left to right Kathy Novak, Randy Bell, and Donna Allmond (not pictured) play offertory and pre and post service music... Mary Jo Bell leads the music, and Regina Smyth leads the readings.

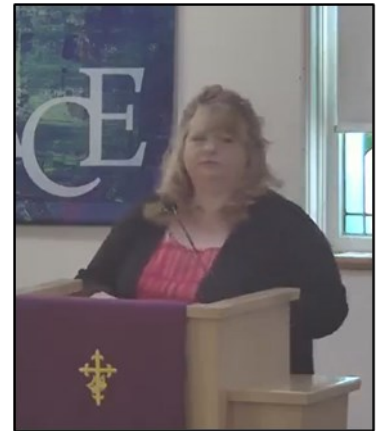
March 27th - Bottom The Seasonal Singers sing "All Praise to Thee, for Thou, O King Divine", a hymn based on Jesus' willingness to give up
