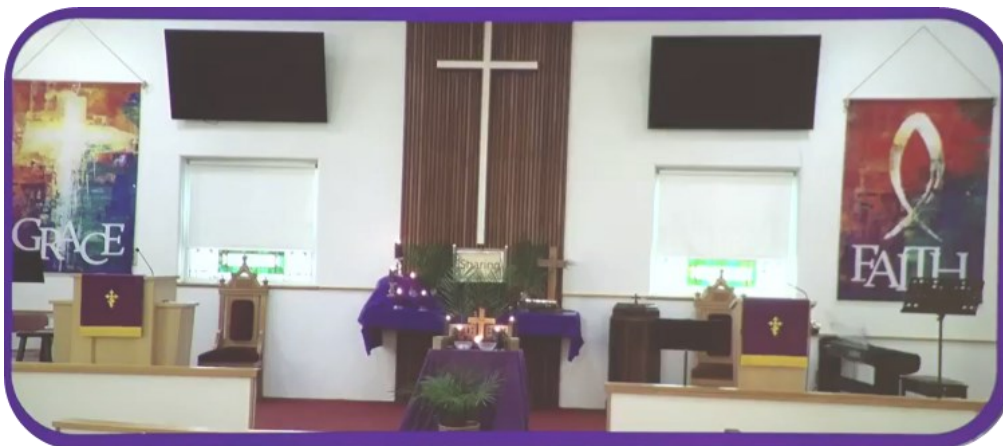
Recent Worship in Pictures

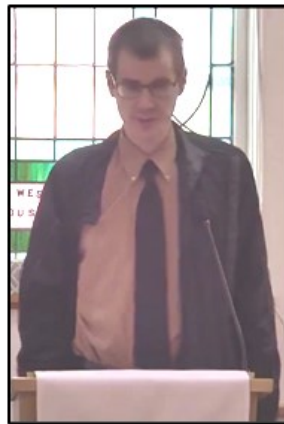

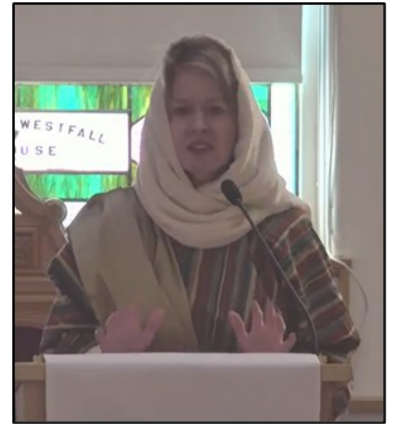

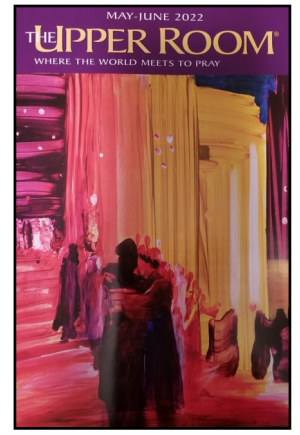
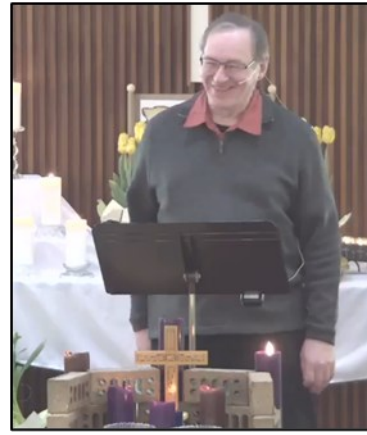


April 17, 10 am Easter Worship -- Dramatic Presentation of He Lives: Top Left to Right Charles Kirkpatrick is the Apostle John speaking of his Easter morning experience. MaryJo Bell is Mary the Mother of Jesus, mourning at the tomb (before she realizes it is empty) Kelly McIntyre is Mary Magdalene telling what Jesus did for her. **Lower Row Above Left to Right** Sara Williams is the angel who rolls the stone away, and then gives the news to Mary M. who had come to the tomb with spices. Then later in the service, after hearing the story of the pair on their way to Emmaus, Pastor Chuck leads the church in Communion.

April 24 - Bright (Easter Joy) Sunday Below -- Seasonal Singers sing two songs on the joy of salvation that is made possible by the resurrection of Jesus -- *Heaven Came Down* and *Sunlight, Sunlight*.

April 24 (cont) Top left to right - Sherri Rice leads the readings, Mary Jo Bell the music, and Pastor Chuck talks about the joy of victorious living. The May-June issue of **The Upper Room** is now available. **Left** - The Lent-Easter Table received its final “foundational brick” of establishing a rock solid relationship in the love of God. The series comes to a close. **Below** - The key word of each week was placed beneath the three crosses in parlor / entryway to the sanctuary, forming the “ground-work” and then swooping upward in rising to victory.
