The Finance Committee wishes to thank all who have provided financial support to the Church. Today we are faced with a significant decrease in giving which began in early 2022.

We began 2022 with a surplus created by the receipt of three rebate payments from the IRS and strong giving to the General Fund. These IRS payroll tax payments were made to small organization under the COVID tax relief acts. Beginning in February general fund offering declined and monthly bills exceeded the offering by over \$2,900 each month. In April the traditional Easter Giving did not occur and by May 3 all of the surplus had been used.

A review of giving revealed three regular and generous members had moved away from Hartland and were no longer giving to this Church.

We fully recognize the issues we all face with rising cost and uncertainty of what the future may bring. If you are able to give even a small amount, every dollar helps.

Online Giving at Hartland United Methodist Church (Vanco)

Giving online has allowed members of our Church to continue providing for the operation of the Church and our outreach ministries. You have the option to provide one-time donations at any time, or setup and schedule recurring donations allowing you to give to one or more of the Church's designated funds. Donations either one-time or recurring, allows you to have money taken out of your bank account or use your debit card. Vanco will sent the request to your bank and your bank will send the money directly to the Hartland Church bank account. The Church Financial Secretary receives a report showing who donated, the amount and how to assign the donation to the appropriate fund General Fund, Emergency Fund, Building Fund...etc. This information is entered each week into your giving statement account. You can stop or change your online donations at any time.

So how does this work?

First go to the Church website – <u>www.hartlandumc.org</u>

Near the bottom of the Web Site page you will see – **Online Giving**, click **Online Giving** to start. Now you will see the Online Donation screen.

You need to decide

- The amount to donate,
- Which funds to donate to (We hope you will choose General Operating Fund)
- Donation Frequency One Time, Weekly, Bi-Weekly or Monthly

Now you will be asked to enter your Donation Information

It's important to understand the fees charged for using a Debit Card. The Church must pay a fee for debit cards and that fee will be taken from your donation and sent to the Debit Card Processing Bank. This is ok, the fee is small. For example the fee for \$35 is only \$1.41 so the Church still receives \$33.59. And you have the option to pay the fee yourself. If you select Checking or Savings, there is no fee and the Church receives the full amount.

Once you're all done, Vanco will process your information and begin sending to the Church.





Deck work begins **Left Top to Bottom** — After the blow of the tree, the outer edge of the deck dropped 4 inches into the ground. Step, and deck ceiling pierced by limbs. After day one, the old deck is stripped down to the joists. New roof support posts put in, Above and to Bottom. New deck floor ,rails, and ceiling put int.
