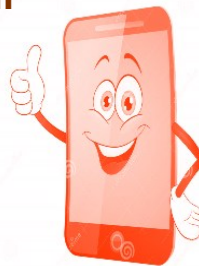

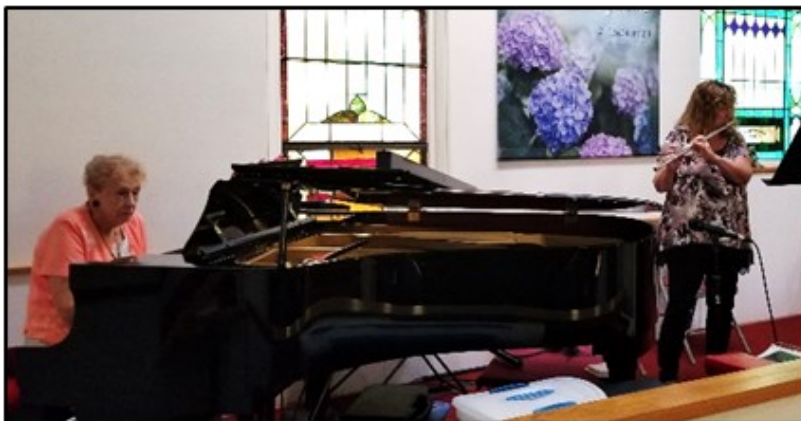
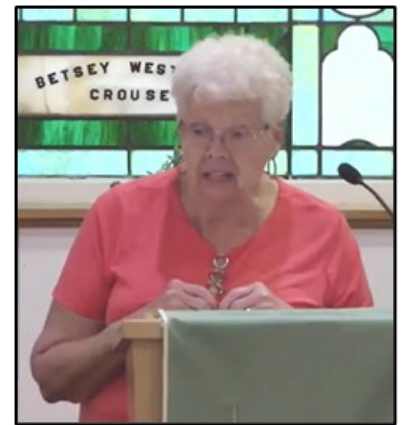
Road from Jerusalem to Jericho

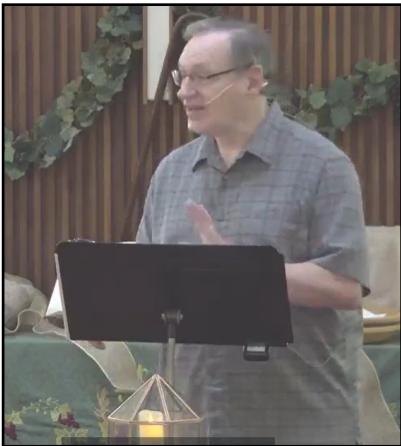




## Recent Worship in Pictures (cont.)
